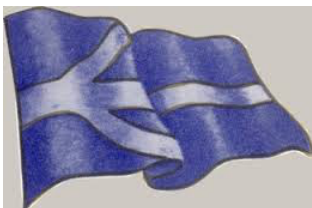


MEMBERSHIP
