We have performed the procedures specified in the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's (ESE) Compliance Supplement applicable to Massachusetts School Districts to the End-of-Year Financial Report prepared by the City of Lawrence, Massachusetts (City) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2010.
